

# University Student Offers

The club provides the following financial support to student members studying at university.

## Track Fees

Harrier Centre track fees will be waived for full-time university students who are aged 18-25 inclusive. This applies both to students living locally and away from home.

***How to apply:*** Please let Di know as soon as possible if this applies to you so that your direct debit can be cancelled. Unfortunately this request cannot be applied retrospectively to refund track fees that have already been paid.

## Competition Travel Expenses

If you are a full-time UK university student living away from home, Epsom and Ewell Harriers will pay reasonable return travel expenses during term time to allow you to represent the club in the following club competitions:

- Southern Athletics League
- Surrey XC League
- South of England XC Championships

Our definition of 'reasonable expenses' covers transportation costs only and requires that you book the cheapest advance fares on public transport. Bus fares are likely to be cheaper than train fares, and you should obtain a discount with a student travel card where possible. Expense claims will normally be capped at £50 per event.

In addition, student athletes may be invited individually by their team manager to have travel expenses reimbursed for other team events, for example to form a competitive relay team. (The team manager must obtain approval from the club trustees before offering for the club to cover these additional expenses.)

***How to apply:*** Please send your travel expenses claim to the team manager, including your bank account details and a copy of any receipts. The team manager will confirm that you did compete and forward the request to [treasurer@epsomandewellharriers.org](mailto:treasurer@epsomandewellharriers.org) for payment.
